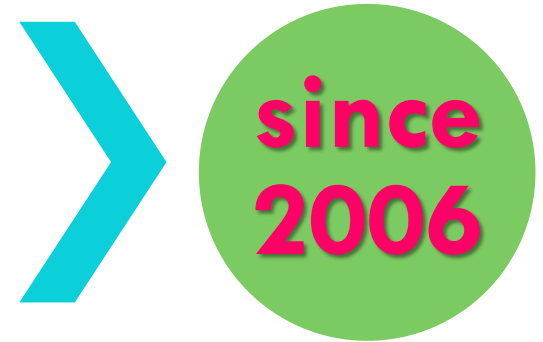
History of the Consortium



Feasibility study

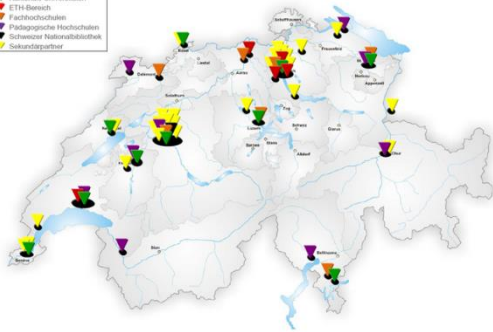
2000-

- 50% share of member libraries

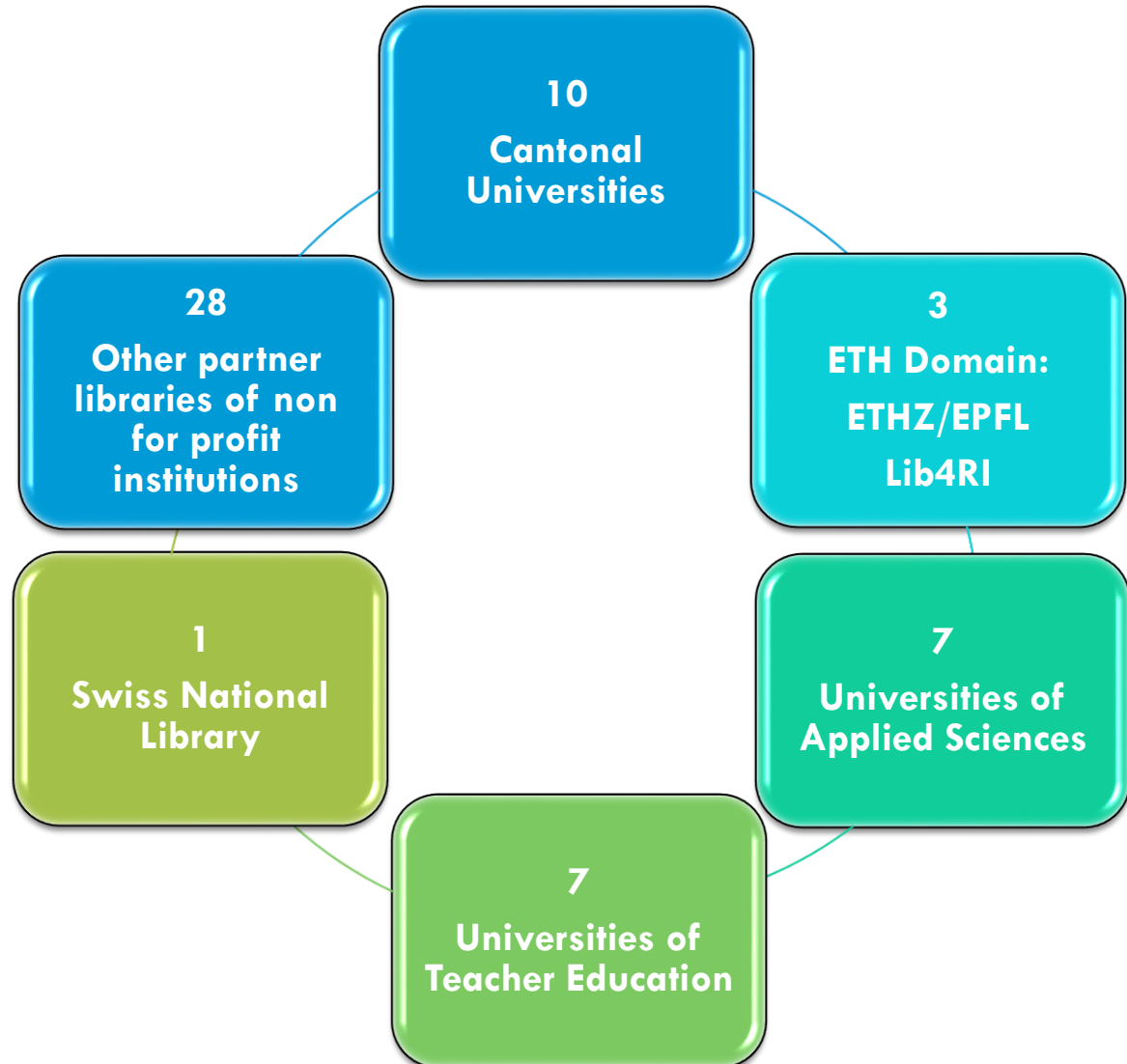

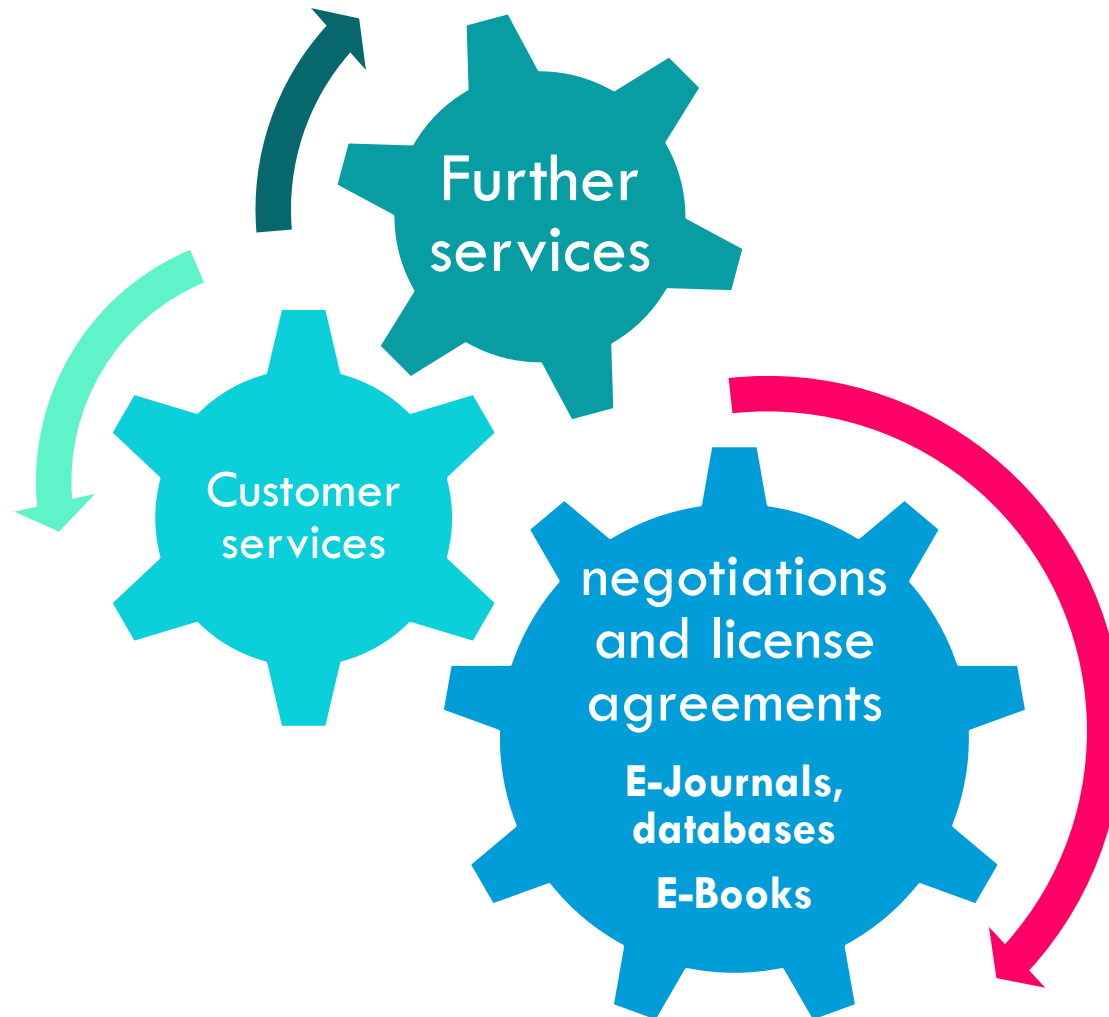

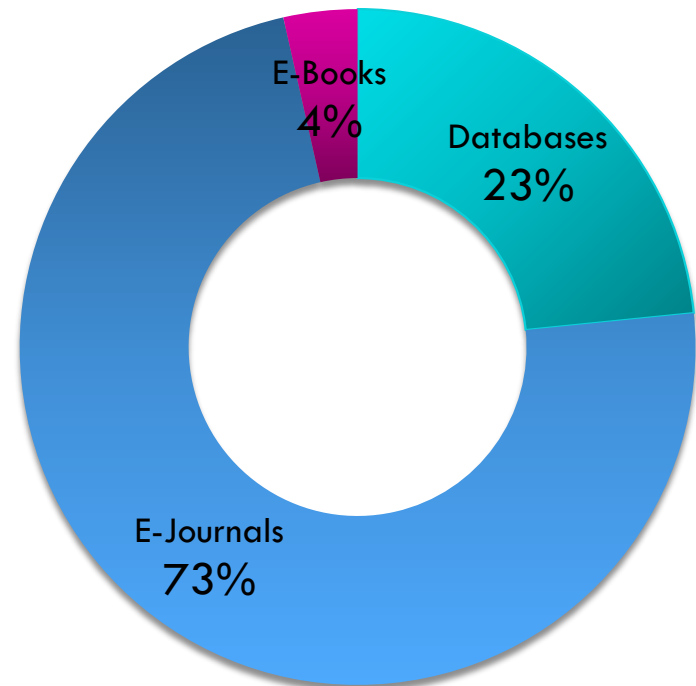

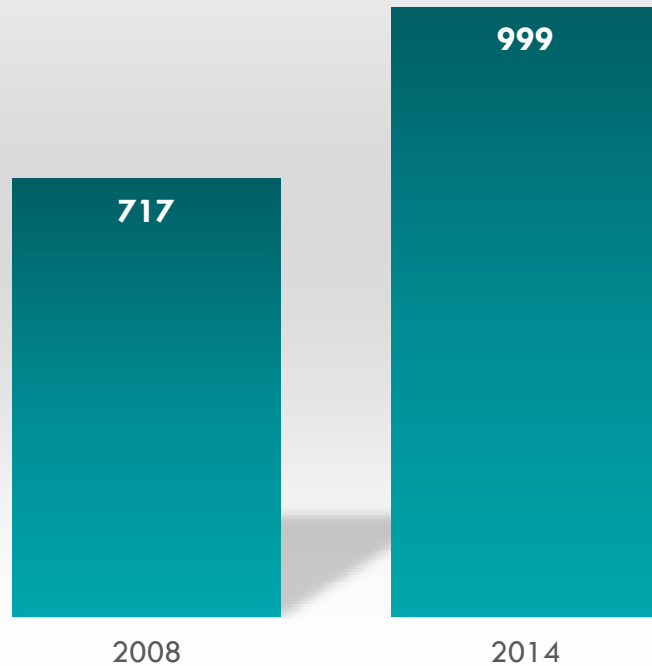

Development of consortia licenses

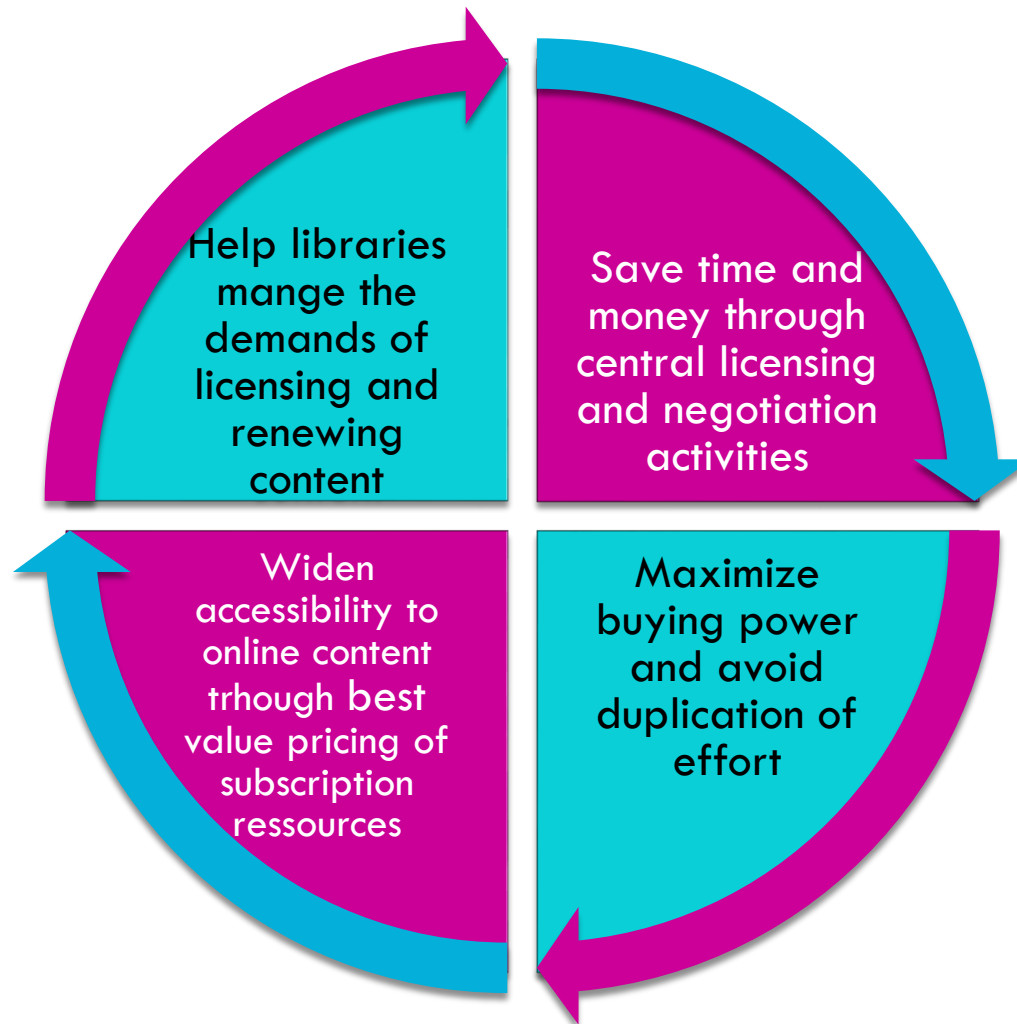
Number of licenses

Objectives of the project

Purchase of backfile archives

- Supply higher education and research community in Switzerland with backfile archives (e-journals, databases and e-books)

Rolling archives and current content

- Coupling backfile-archives to current content licenses – thereby growing of archives continuously (close gaps) is ensured

Infrastructure for long-term preservation

- Long-term access, including Portico and LOCKSS options
- Management (metadata, authentication, usage statistics)

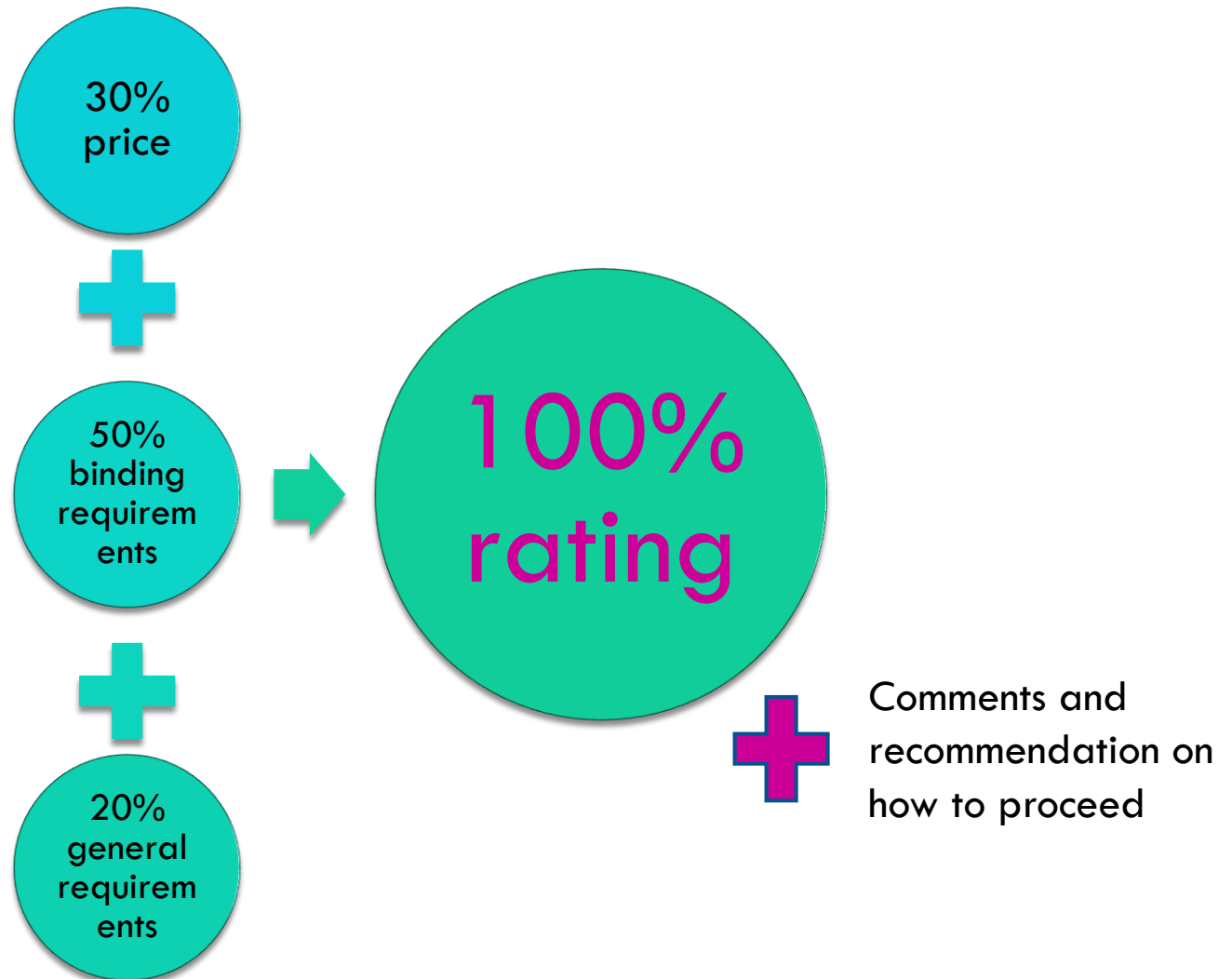
